Move Type Definitions

<u>First Duty Civilian</u> – The <u>first</u> move for the <u>first</u> tour of duty for a <u>new</u> Air Force civilian (OR re-employed after a break in service of 4 or more days*) whether it be within the Continental United States (CONUS), Overseas Outside the Continental United States (OCONUS), or a Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States (NF-OCONUS) location. (DOES NOT include employees coming from other federal agencies)

<u>CONUS to CONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from a Continental United States (CONUS) location (48 contiguous states) to another CONUS location. **Example**: Hanscom Air Force Base, MA to Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, OH

<u>CONUS to OCONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from a Continental United States (CONUS) location (48 contiguous states) to an Overseas location Outside the Continental United States (F- OCONUS) location. **Example**: Hanscom AFB, MA to Lakenheath AFB, UK

<u>CONUS to NF-OCONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from a Continental United States (CONUS) location (48 contiguous states) to a Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States location. **Example**: Hanscom Air Force Base, MA to Eielson AFB, AK

<u>OCONUS to CONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from Overseas, Outside the Continental United States (OCONUS) to a Continental United States (CONUS) location (48 contiguous states). **Example**: Ramstein Air Base, GE to Wright-Patterson AFB, OH

<u>OCONUS to OCONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from an Overseas Foreign Outside the Continental United States location to another Overseas Outside the Continental United States location. **Example**: Incirlik AB, Turkey to Ramstein AB, GE

<u>OCONUS to NF-OCONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from Overseas (Outside the Continental United States) location to a Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States location. **Example**: Ramstein AB, GE to Eielson AFB, AK

<u>NF-OCONUS to CONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from a Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States location to a Continental United States (CONUS) 48 contiguous states location. **Example**: Hickam AFB, HI to Wriight-Patterson AFB, OK

<u>NF-OCONUS to OCONUS</u> — A current federal employee making a career move from a Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States location to an Overseas Foreign location. **Example**: Hickam AFB, HI to Lakenheath AB, UK

<u>NF-OCONUS to NF-OCONUS</u> – A current federal employee making a career move from a Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States location to another Non-Foreign Outside the Continental United States location. **Example**: Hickam AFB, HI to Elmendorf AFB, AK

Retirement or Separation – A retiring or separating (voluntary or involuntary) civilian employee from a Foreign OCONUS or Non-Foreign OCONUS location only.

***Members retiring or separating from a CONUS location are NOT entitled to PCS. One exception – retirement of an SES employee with their last move. ***

ACRONYMS

CONUS: Locations within the 48 Contiguous States. **NF-OCONUS:** Locations in the US States and Territories not within the 48 Contiguous States, i.e., Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, etc.

OCONUS: Locations in Foreign Overseas Countries, i.e., Germany, Japan, Italy, United Kingdom, etc.
